# 2022-2023 Goals and Actions Steps

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## Goal:

In the 2023-2024 school year, SCA's content mastery score in each grade level and content area will increase by at least 6% or remain at the maintenance level of performance based on 3rd-8th grade GMAS testing from the 2022-2023 school year.

- Action Step #1:  
Provide additional staff training on SCA's curriculum resources and model.
- Action Step #2:  
Expand instructional supports through Goal-Time design, MTSS program, and co-teaching model in grades K-8 to support academic instruction.
- Action Step #3:  
Employ Instructional Leadership Staff and Academic Support Staff to support SCA's Instructional Staff.

# 2022-2023 Goals and Actions Steps

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## Goal:

In the 2023-2024 school year, SCA will see an increase of at least two levels of understanding on a 1-5 scale in at least 80% of the families, community members, and stakeholders attending events designed to deepen the understanding of SCA's educational model.

- Action Step #1:

Educate parents and families on Habits of Character, Standards-Based Grading, Student-led Conferences, and innovative school model.

- Action Step #2:

Implement long-range strategic planning process led by SCA's Board and Leadership Team.

- Action Step #3:

Expand Torch Partner Program and design additional programs to increase engagement of families, community members, and additional stakeholders.
